Dear Ms. Bose:

Pursuant to Section 4 of the Natural Gas Act (“NGA”) and Part 154.205(a) of the Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”),¹ Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company, L.L.C. (“Tennessee”) hereby withdraws in its entirety its Scheduling Priority Tariff Provisions Tariff Records to Implement and Motion into Effect, Previously Filed As *pro forma* Tariff Records, which Tennessee submitted on December 9, 2011 and was docketed under Docket No. RP12-232-000.²

Tennessee intended that the Scheduling Priority Tariff Provisions Tariff Records to Implement and Motion into Effect, Previously Filed As *pro forma* Tariff Records be docketed with its Rate Case proceeding under Docket No. RP11-1566, not under a separate docket. Because of a meta data error in Tennessee’s electronic tariff submission, Tennessee’s filing was not correctly coded as “Associated” with Tennessee’s Rate Case proceeding under Docket No. RP11-1566.

Given the fact that the Commission has not acted on Tennessee’s December 9, 2011 tariff filing under Docket No. RP12-232-000, Tennessee respectfully requests that the Commission allow Tennessee to withdraw its filing in its entirety under Docket No. RP12-232-000. Tennessee will separately resubmit the Scheduling Priority Tariff Provisions Tariff Records to Implement and Motion into Effect, Previously Filed As *pro forma* Tariff Records in the proper Docket No. RP11-1566, with the same effective date of February 1, 2012.
